Creating a Print With Borders Using Photoshop

Detailed Steps

(Also see the full video tutorial which contains this at the end.)

1. Duplicate Image, selecting merging layers checkbox
2. Check that image size is large enough to print on your paper size. If not, use Image Size, bicubic enlargement to make it bigger in steps.
3. Add a thin black border:
Canvas Size
.05 inches width
.05 inches height
Black color
Relative checkbox selected

4. Add a white border for the image itself:

Canvas Size

.18 inches width

.18 inches height

White color

Relative checkbox selected

5. Add a black border for cutting the print:

Canvas Size

.2 inches width

.2 inches height

Black color

Relative checkbox selected

6. Add a white border to use no ink for cropping :
Canvas Size
2 inches width
2 inches height
White color
Relative checkbox selected
7. If you shoot in Adobe RGB,
Edit, Convert Profile To
and convert to sRGB
8. Save the file as a JPG in another folder with jpg quality 9.
9. After printing, delete the JPG print file at your
convenience. It's a throw away
